You will know that there is a great deal of uncertainty surrounding the UK currently because of BREXIT and whilst this will not affect your visit directly, we have not been able to confirm if there will be any impact on travelling to the UK with dogs. It is likely that nothing will change from the information on our website by the time of the event as it is within the 9 month "transition period" HOWEVER, it is possible that there may be a requirement for a positive rabies tire test to be recorded in the dog's pet passport and so we are recommending that anyone who is intending to bring a dog to the event has a titre test done as soon as possible – preferably before the end of January, 2019.
